

Procedure for the election of new members

- The person interested in becoming a member contacts the office (office@daylight.academy) or is suggested by a current member.
- 2. The office verifies (if needed with the help of the steering committee) that the potential candidate's profile meets the requirement¹ of the Academy.
- 3. If this is the case, this person is invited to an Annual Conference or another DLA meeting.
- 4. After having participated in a meeting, the person sends to the office a short motivation letter together with two recommendation letters (nominations) from current members.
- 5. The office informs the steering committee, which decides if and when (at which General Assembly) the nominee should be elected as a new member.
- 6. If the steering committee approves the nomination, the office registers the nominee as a candidate.
- 7. A list of candidates is sent to all members before the general assembly with the request to inform the steering committee if there are concerns about a candidate:
 - a. If there are concerns, the steering committee decides how to proceed (e.g. mediation, exclusion, invitation to try again) and informs the candidate.
 - b. If there are no concerns, the candidate is invited to the next general assembly.
- 8. At the general assembly, the candidate presents him- or herself and explains his or her motivation for becoming a member.
- 9. The members elect the new member.

¹ See eligibility / Art. 6 a) of the Statutes: "Members are outstanding representatives and opinion leaders from all countries and disciplines, doing research or application related to daylight. They show: Leadership in science, architecture or other professional areas, international background and outreach, dedicated to being an ambassador for daylight & its effects, open-minded, with a track record for out-of-the-box and interdisciplinary thinking".
